

This is more of an introduction to knots than a comprehensive "bible". But a lot of important knots are presented here. The photos generally work very well. The spiral binding is first rate and it allows you to lay the book on a desk and use both hands with the rope. I have several other books on knots but this is the only one with lay-flat spiral binding. Don't let the spiral binding make you think that this book has been inexpertly or cheaply made. The quality is very good.

Really love the layout and detail of this book. Like others have said, the spiral binding makes this a lot easier to use. I tried a couple of other online knot references.... never could get the Figure 8 knot down. This one made it so easy that I got it on the first Try! That doesn't mean I'm not struggling with some of the others, but that's just because I'm a beginner at this I think Love it!!!!
