

Lovely food designs and a great way to learn highlighting. Kari's highlights on the food are absolutely amazing and that's the main reason I purchased this book. Step by step instructions are included for basic food shapes (cones, spheres, tubes, etc.), and then she moves on to fine tuning your food and ends with highlighting instructions. Also has great felting supply sources in the back of the book.

Fetilicious has a nice variety of different needle felting projects all in the food theme. Some of my favorites include the Root Beer Float, Pumpkin Pie, Macaron and Pop Tart. Each project has beautiful photo of the finished item and step by step color photos to guide you in making your own. This keeps it easy to understand and beautiful to look at. I also liked that it goes into shading your pieces, something I haven't really seen included in other needle felting books. Depending on what

you are working on, this can have a really cool effect. I like when diagrams for actual sizing are included. It's nice to check your work and make sure size wise you are on the right track, however this doesn't hinder my ability to follow the instructions and complete the projects. If you have never needle felted before, there is a section on the front of the book that goes over tools you will need and how it is done. If you are still not quite sure, try looking up needle felting tutorials on youtube. There are many good ones, I recommend Maqaroon and Flying Mio in particular. Sometimes actually watching someone do it will click everything into place. It is a fun, relaxing craft, don't give up! It's very rewarding.

First of all the book is beautifully illustrated, designed and printed.....pure class! Kerri Wessel's felted food pieces are whimsical and masterfully done. The pieces often brought smiles to my face....they are choc full of personality. I found this book to be perfect for all levels of needle felting. Kerri and Kari provide the beginner with the info needed to get started yet describe techniques like working highlights into your piece which will help the advanced felter achieve a more realistic and natural finished piece. An excellent resource and a delight to add to your bookshelf.

I am a visual crafter. I get inspired by ideas by looking at finished products . After browsing the pages of this book, its very engaging. If you cannot find time to make them, honestly this book is still worth the purchase. I am loving the therapeutic effect of this craft. The fundamentals of felting are visually easy here. I love that the first part of this book is shape techniques of circles square triangle and that impacted me how easy it is to create my own twist. I made an open red mouth shark project . My friends were impressed. I owe my inspiration from the visuals of this book. I got diverted but still working on my kiwi and strawberry slices for my dessert cake! Colorful, fun, playful ,cover to cover color illustrations...food inspired craft projects in my opinion is timeless. So fun!

This book is fantastic, the basic supply list is well thought out (using pet brushes as carders is genius.) It gives clear instructions with images to go along with it. The shading on all the items is well done and easy to follow. I can easily see these felted foods in a childs kitchen replacing plastic ones. I plan to make the chocolate bunnies for my childrens Easter basket. As a felting teacher and enthusiast I highly recommend this book. The skills you develop making these projects can easily be applied to future felting projects.

I've bought several wool felting books for my sister who is amazing at felting animals, so I thought

she might like to venture out and create some felt food fuzzies. I loved the whimsy and amazing detail of the pieces, and the instructions were well done. My sister loves it.
