

I also enjoyed the anecdotes.I have only two very minor issues....I wish they showed a gray horse. My gray is certainly a challenge to keep clean and any tips and tricks are always appreciated. Not just for competition horses. Every horse, no matter what size or breed, and anyone handling horses (barn managers, owners, instructors, students, riders, grooms) would benefit greatly from the kind of care and maintenance described here. The text is laid out in block and numbered paragraphs, supported by sharply focused, close up professional quality photos. Easy detailed explanations that anyone can read and understand, from ages 8 through 100. The spiral binding allows you to lay the book opened flat on any handy surface for easy reference while you're performing the various grooming techniques. Shows the correct and incorrect ways of doing things in photos as well. The authors know what they're talking about, having taken care of horses owned and ridden by some of the most demanding owners in the world. EXCELLENT gift for that horse lover friend of yours. Christmas is coming soon and you need not wait to until then to gift it.
